Ontario Works Programs (continued)

Direct Shelter Subsidy

- Assisted 88 families in 2011
- Currently 46 families – spending \$7,035/m
- 48% at max compared to 41% for 2010

Chapleau Employment Ontario

- Registered 56 / Assisted 1,537 in the RC
- 49% employed
- 17% education / training / 10 incentive placements

Summer Jobs for Youth

- Funded Placements 40 / Applied 70 / Placed 57
- Completed 51 / PT placement 8
