Housing & Homelessness Plans

Housing Service Act, 2011 Local Housing and Homelessness Plans

Province identified provincial interests in housing through a Housing Policy Statement.

New legislation requires Service Managers to undertake comprehensive local planning for housing and homelessness, identifying needs and establishing priorities.

10 year planning horizon, renewed at least every five years
Province will have the opportunity to comment on plans before they are finalized.

Plans are approved by DSB Board

Implementation: first plans would be due one year after legislation enacted.
