PURPOSE

All EMAs/Paramedics shall report incoming patient status to a CACC in a consistent format so that they can provide pertinent information to the receiving emergency department in order to prepare for the patient.

APPLICATION

Paramedics, EMAs

PROCEDURE

- 1) When reporting incoming patients to a communications officer all Paramedics/EMAs will follow the format below:
 - a) Vehicle number
 - b) Number of patients carried
 - c) CTAS Level (1-5) upon patient contact
 - d) CTAS Level (1-5) upon leaving scene
 - e) Transport Priority Code
 - f) Comments
