PURPOSE

To ensure all Patient Care is provided in accordance with acceptable standards and legislated Patient Care Standards.

APPLICATION

Paramedics, EMAs, Management

PROCEDURE

- 1) EMAs and Paramedics shall provide patient care in accordance with BLS/ALS standards.
- 2) Quality assurance will be a joint effort between management staff and Base Hospital.
- 3) Management shall monitor compliance on an ongoing basis and initiate remedial action where required.
