PURPOSE

To ensure that all staff while being paid for training, CME and Examinations are wearing all safety equipment that is normally required to perform their regular duties.

APPLICATION

Paramedics, EMAs, Management

PROCEDURE

- 1) While attending paid training, CME or testing, staff shall wear full uniform, to include shirt, pants and safety footwear.
 - a) Staff in violation of this policy shall not be allowed to continue any training, CME or testing until such time as they meet the outlines of this policy and have made arrangements with the instructor to return to the session.
 - b) Staff who are not allowed by the instructor to return to the training, CME or testing shall assume full responsibility for making their own arrangements for taking the training, CME or testing at their own expense and time.
