PURPOSE

To monitor all Manitoulin-Sudbury DSB EMS vehicle movement and utilization of warning systems

APPLICATION

Paramedics, EMAs, Management

PROCEDURE

Manitoulin-Sudbury DSB EMS continuously records vehicle movement information through a satellite based/telephone tower (GPS) Automated Vehicle Locating (AVL) system. Equipment for this purpose is installed on all ambulances and ERV's.

- Vehicle movements and use of warning systems can be monitored at any time from the Grey Island website.
- Manitoulin-Sudbury DSB EMS Ambulance speed policy is monitored by utilizing GPS readings and daily automatically generated speed reports.
- Information will be stored for a period of at least 5 years.
- GPS/AVL can be accessed by CACC to aid in deployment of vehicles to emergency calls.
