PURPOSE

To ensure that the Manitoulin-Sudbury Emergency Medical Services complies with the current Provincial Equipment Standards For Ontario Ambulance Services and the current Land Ambulance and Emergency Response Vehicle Standards.

APPLICATION

Director, Operations Manager, Quality Assurance Manager

PROCEDURE

- 1) Management shall ensure that all-patient care equipment, accessory equipment and emergency response vehicles that are purchased meet the above standards.
- 2) Management shall ensure that all equipment and accessories utilized in Ambulances/ERUs/ESUs meet the above standards.
- 3) Management shall ensure that each ambulance contains as a minimum the accessories and patient care equipment set out in the above standards.
- 4) Management shall ensure that all Ambulances, ERUs and ESUs comply with the above standards.
- 5) Management shall ensure that any modification made to equipment, accessories or emergency vehicles (Ambulances, ERUs, ESUs) meet with the above standards and are documented. The modifications must be approved by EHS in writing and retained on file for that vehicle.
