

Responsibility for the delivery of land ambulance services across the Districts of Manitoulin and Sudbury was assumed by the DSB on January 1, 2001 after Ontario divested its Land Ambulance responsibilities province wide. In addition to the actual land ambulance services that were assumed, responsibility for Emergency First Response Teams (EFRT), which are not regulated under the Ontario Ambulance Act, were retained as part of an integral Emergency Medical Care system for our jurisdiction.
